


What will you need to make your Stop Motion Animation Film?




Camera: digital camera, a phone or tablet



Tripod or something to hold your camera in the same position.








Writing Paper or the Storyboard Template.

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STOP MOTION ANIMATION - DAY I


Today's activity:

Put on your writing cap, because today you are going to write a movie! Today you are going to think of a story that you would like to write and turn into a stop motion animation film. You can use the Storyboard Template that we have provided to help write your story.

Stop Motion Animation is a fun way of making movies for beginners and is also a way professional animators make movies. Using Lego, clay, figurines, teddies etc., you move your characters a little bit at a time and take pictures of every movement. When you put all the pictures together it will give you the illusion of a moving image. By the end of this week you will produce your own movie!

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STOP MOTION ANIMATION - DAY 2


Today's activity:

You will need to choose 1 or 2 main characters that will move in your film. These can be toys, candy, book etc. Use your imagination! Since there are no spoken words in Stop Motion Animation, the story will need to be told with movement and signs only. Hmmm it is problem solving time..how are you going to tell your story without speaking?

Think about how you can use music, signs, movement, and a scene to help you feel emotion. You could write one story and give it many different feelings just by changing these aspects. When you write your story make sure you think about these components too!

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STOP MOTION ANIMATION - DAY 3

Today's activity:

Today we are going to make our scenes! Pick a space with lots of natural light in front of a window, and a space that you can leave your scene set up for a few days. Your scene is

anything that is going to stay still during your filming and help to tell your story.



Your scene can be as simple or complicated as you would like! Do you have a favorite bat cave, doll house or lego set? These are all great starting points to use for your movie.

If you want to make a more simple movie you can also use paper and make it two dimensional on a table. Use the resources you have available and your imagination. Share your sets

STOP MOTION ANIMATION - DAY 4

Today's activity:

It's picture taking day! Remember small movements are better, and take a picture every time you move an item.

The more pictures and movements the better. You will want to take at the very least 30 pictures to see movement in your film, but longer movies could be 1000's of pictures!

TIP:

Use a camera stand, tri-pod or a home made stand. You will want to keep your camera in the same position for every picture you take.


If you need to take pictures

over two days, make sure you work

during the same time of day

for the same light.

Today's activity:

Congratulations everyone, you have almost finished your movie! Using the animation app you have chosen, add all of your pictures into the film. You can also add music or sounds, and for the more experienced there are lots of other features available. We can't wait to see your movies!
